

TROLLEY TRACK REMOVAL ON ERIE AVENUE

Anticipated Friday, November 9 to Tuesday, November 13, 2018

Project is weather dependent.

What is happening?

The City and SEPTA will be removing 70 feet of unused trolley track in the intersection of Broad Street and Erie Avenue [see map]. These trolley tracks in Erie Avenue have not been used for a long time. Unused trolley tracks make maintenance of the roadway significantly more challenging and also present a challenge to cross for people walking and biking.

Transit Detours:

- The Broad Street Line subway will not be impacted by this work.
- The Route 56 and 53 buses will be detoured to Pike Street and Butler Street.
- The Route 16 and the Broad Street Owl will detour to Old York Road.
- The Routes H and XH will layover at Germantown Avenue and Luzerne Street, adjacent to the Post Office. They can also be boarded at 16th and Erie for service northbound.

Driving Detours:

- Broad Street will be temporarily closed through this intersection for the entire construction period.
- Erie Avenue will be closed periodically.
- Local traffic will still have access to the businesses in the area.
- A limited amount of on-street parking near corners may be removed to allow vehicles to turn.
- Vehicles on Broad Street will be directed to use Germantown Avenue during the temporary closure of Broad Street. Erie Avenue traffic will detour to Pike and Butler Streets when Erie Avenue is temporarily closed.

When this is happening?

This work requires Broad Street at Erie Avenue to be temporarily shut down to traffic. Detour signs will be posted.

- Friday, November 9: Detours are expected to begin at approximately 6:00 PM and continue through the night. Work will occur overnight.
- Saturday November 10, Sunday, November 11, and Monday, November 12: work is expected during the day.
